

PALAY PROCUREMENT


For the month of November, NFA procured 153,937 bags (7,696.85 MT) of palay, which is 3.69% accomplishment of the month's target of 3,678,950 bags (183,947.5 MT). The decrease in volume of procurement compared to last month's level is due to the end of harvest season. Nevertheless, National Food Authority will still continue to provide the best service to farmers and farmers organization, to entice them to sell their harvested stocks to NFA.

DISTRIBUTION

For the month of November, NFA distributed 155,615 bags (7,780.75 MT) of rice, equivalent to 22.12% accomplishment of the month's target of 703,475 bags (35,173.75 MT). A total of 49,791 bags of rice were issued to LGUs and DSWD for relief operations and response to calamity.

NFA INVENTORY

As of November 30, 2023, NFA's Total Expected Milled Rice Inventory (TEMRI) stock inventory of 1,142,294 (57,115 MT). It should be noted that NFA's inventory is only intended for relief operations and calamity response and only part of the national rice inventory of the entire country.
