


I. OPERATIONS COORDINATION DEPARTMENT

A. Ensure Food Security through Maintenance of Adequate Buffer Stock Sourced from Local Farmers

1. Palay Procurement

For the month of June, NFA procured 355,910 bags (17,795.5 MT) of palay, towards the tail-end of harvest season. Procurement accomplishment is 125.94% as NFA exceeded its target of 282,600 bags (14,130 MT), due to the continuous implementation of the PRICERS program to encourage more farmers to deliver and sell their palay harvest to NFA especially in areas with sporadic harvest.



2. Distribution

For the month of June, NFA distributed 63,556 bags (3,177.8 MT) of milled rice, equivalent to 12.67% accomplishment vis-a-vis, the target of 501,600 bags (25,080 MT) and was issued to the following:

- 39,404 bags to DSWD, OCD, Legislators, and LGU's for relief operations / calamity response
- 24,101 bags for government agencies and LGU's rice requirement under EO-51 program
- 50 bags issued for the AO no.2 One-Time Rice Allowance (OTRA)



3. NFA Inventory

As of June 30, 2024, NFA has a Total Expected Milled Rice Inventory (TEMRI) stock inventory of 2,943,976 bags (147,199 MT). It should be noted that NFA's inventory is only a part of the national rice inventory of the entire country.
