Just like the local farmers spreading seeds sown directly in the field which is one of the methods in planting palay, the publication's purpose is to spread and convey relevant information to the NFA employees as well as to the stakeholders and the public as a whole.

CEREMONIAL SIGNING OF THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR PALLGU BETWEEN LGU BARCELONA, SORSOGON AND NFA BICOL REGION

To help and support the local farmers of Barcelona, Sorsogon increasing their income during harvest season, its local government headed by Honorable Mayor Cynthia Falcotelo-Fortes agreed to enter into Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with National Food Authority Bicol Region on Palay Marketing Assistance for Legislators and Local Government Units (PALLGU) program.

PALLGU is one of NFA's programs wherein the Legislators or heads of LGUs enter into an



agreement with NFA where the participating LGUs shall provide a premium amount of at least Php1.00/kg or an amount determined by the Legislator/LGU using as reference the prevailing market price, to be added to the existing NFA support price for the purchase of palay from Individual Farmers / Farmers Organizations / Farmers Cooperative (IF/FOs/FCs) in their area of jurisdiction.

Mayor Fortes knowing the plight of farmers during planting, harvesting, and selling their palay, agreed to offer a premium price of Php 1.00 per kg in addition to the existing buying price of Php19.00/kg for the purchase of palay from individual palay farmers, palay farmers' organizations/ Cooperatives (FOs/FCs) in their area. LGU Barcelona was the first municipality in Sorsogon that participated in the said program.

On March 22, 2023, the ceremonial activity for the signing of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between LGU Barcelona and NFA was held at the Municipal Hall of Barcelona. Present were Regional Manager Osmundo Guinto, Jr. of NFA Bicol Region, Honorable Mayor Cynthia Falcotelo-Fortes, NFA Sorsogon Branch, BM Julie B. Llenaresas and ABM Arvin B. Lazaro and the Leaders/Chairpersons of different Farmers Associations/Organization in Barcelona.

RM Guinto expressed his gratitude to Mayor Fortes for her full support to the local farmers and for being the first Municipality in Sorsogon to enter PALLGU program with NFA. He assured that in return for their trust to NFA, the Branch will do their best effort to cater the palay deliveries of farmers from Barcelona. This will be used as rice buffer stocks which will be distributed during calamities and emergencies.



Farmer leaders who participated in the said activity also expressed their appreciation to Mayor Fortes and to the NFA Bicol Region for the support and effort they have given to them.

The ceremonial activity ended with a picture taking with the local farmers in front of the Municipal Hall. (CHARLYN D. ESTARRES)

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF CAMARINES NORTE SIGNS MOA ON PALLGU WITH NFA BICOL REGION

(From page 1) Under the said program, the provincial government will add a maximum of PhP5.00 per kilogram to the current NFA Palay Buying Price of PhP19.00. This is to encourage farmers to deliver their palay harvest to the NFA to assist the latter in securing sufficient rice buffer stock. This will bring the palay buying price to a maximum of PhP24.00 per kilogram (for clean and dry palay). Breakdown of the PhP5.00 is as follows: Premium: PhP3.00, Drying Incentive: PhP1.00, Handling / Delivery Incentive: PhP1.00 (maximum depending on the distance).

The Provincial Government will initially download a total of PhP3,300,000.00 to the NFA Camarines Sur Branch to fund the pilot implementation of the program.

Aside from the PhP5.00 increment to the palay buying price, the Provincial Government will also grant non-interest bearing loans (in kind) to further help the farmers. To assure loan repayment, the NFA shall deduct loan payables from the proceeds of their palay sales to the NFA. Loan repayment will assure continuity of the program and the possibility of identifying additional farmer beneficiaries should the pilot implementation be a success.

As for the Provincial Government, they will be assured of the availability of NFA Rice for distribution to their constituents in times of emergencies and calamities.

After the MOA signing, RM Abapo expressed his gratitude to the good governor for his full support to the PALLGU program of the NFA. He is hopeful that the effort will be a precedent which will encourage other LGUs and legislators to do the same. Likewise, Governor Padilla thanked the NFA for partnering with the local government in extending assistance to the farmers. He said that it has been his vision to help the farmers and he is happy that finally it is now realized. Most delighted were the farmers who will most benefit from the concerted efforts of the two institution. They conveyed their gratitude that ultimately, their clamor for support has been heard.
